Employee Purchase Plan (EPP)

To be eligible for the wireless Employee Purchase Plan (EPP) you must:

- Show current proof of employment with your corporate ID badge
- Present the Employer/Employee Consent Forms to a SaskTel Store or Authorized Dealer at the time of activation or upgrade

An employee is eligible for one device on the EPP and can select from the preferred rate plans as outlined below, or any other business rate plan that SaskTel may have in the market at the time of activation. At the end of your employment with City of Regina, you are no longer eligible for the EPP rate plans and must change to a consumer rate plan.
